ABOUT THE AIS

The AIS is regarded throughout the world as being at the forefront of elite athlete development and the Institute's soccer program is testament to that reputation. International players such as Mark Viduka, Craig Moore, Ned Zelic, Marco Bresciano and current Australian Socceroos coach Frank Farina have all come through the AIS Soccer Program.
