Playing at Beacon Hill High School Grounds?

Please note the Western driveway of the High School will be out of action after this weekend (28th / 29th July) till approximately November as the driveway is being ripped up. The gate access was supposed to be locked a few weeks ago but the workers were kind enough to allow us three extra weeks of entry that way.

The Primary School (Eastern) carpark will remain open. However, this is a limited space area. People might consider parking in Tristram Road (South of HS Grounds), to the West of this in Boyer Road or in Willandra Road (East of Kerry Close and Egan Place).
