Dear all oval users,

Council has received a few complaints lately from a neighbouring resident adjacent to Balmoral oval regarding noise after training sessions have finished.

Training is booked and is permitted until 9pm after this time all oval users should leave the oval and surrounds quickly and quietly, lately this has not been the case resulting in frequent complaints of noise disturbances after 9pm, noise consisting of yelling and general noise from large groups still training at Balmoral oval.
